No injury is too mild to ignore or too severe to lose hope.

Brain injury is the leading cause of death and disability among children and youth in the United States. It is estimated that 175,000 people in New Jersey are living with the life-long impacts of brain injury.

Each year approximately 9,000 in New Jersey people will be hospitalized due to a brain injury. The number of those who are not hospitalized, and therefore do not receive diagnosis or treatment, is not known.

Since 1981, the Brain Injury Alliance of New Jersey has worked towards its vision of a world in which all individuals with brain injury and their caregivers maximize their quality of life, the consequences of brain injury are minimized, and all preventable brain injuries are prevented.
